
Chapter A - Basic Search


1. Login to GeJL using your credential details




2. In order to promote basic search enter desired subject in basic search field



3. You will get to the results




4. In order to filter search results by specific subject areas navigate to left pane, click on "Show more", select desired area/areas and apply the filter




5. Filters for Author, Journal and Year of publication are available as well:




6. You can also search unlimited number of times within your existing search results. In order to do so, type the desired keyword in "Refine Search" box:

7. By clicking on "Subject" icon, the graphic chart view of articles across all subject categories will be displayed.




The amount of articles per each category is indicated in the graph as well:

8. By clicking on "Journals" icon, the list of all journals with articles in your search results will be displayed.








10. In order to start a new search, type desired keyword in the search field and



You will get the list of all articles related to a new keyword, e.g. Germany.



Don't get confused and make sure not to click on "Refine Search" button because you will just further refine your search results. Also, pay attention to the keywords in your "Search Term". E.g.: When clicking on "Refine Search", you will get to a list of engineering and mechanical articles related to Germany! But when clicking on "New Search", you will get to a list of articles related to Germany only!



Refined subject selection is possible when clicking on "+" sign:





 - Latest updates: where you can find the most articles of specific journals











Chapter E – My Account

In order to use "Search History", "View Marked Results" and "My Favorite Journals" you must first create your own Open Journal Account.


16. Go to My Account and click on the hyperlink "Click here" as indicated below:




19. To save your search results of significant importance, go to Current Search Results, select desired results and click on save.




Your selected search results are now saved and available to you at any time. This allows time saving when doing research.

21. You will be then redirected to a new page where you can view all your marked articles and where you can also select which ones you want to email, print or delete.




Chapter H - My Faourite Journals

My Favourite Journals – allows you to set alerts to inform you when a new article on specified subject of your interest is published in the selected journals.


22. In order to set the alerts, follow these steps:




23. Go to "Create Alerts" tab and type desired keyword of your interest in the search field. You can also select subject within which you wish to perform the search.
